HandL UTM Grabber V3 integrates with JotForm very easily.

**IFRAME**

**FEEDBACK BUTTON**
This code will place a button aligned to a side of the screen. Just copy and paste!

**POP-UP**
Embed the code above as a link or a button to have your form pop-up in a new window.

**LIGHTBOX**
Use this code to have your form appear in a lightbox.

Before you paste the code in your WordPress editor. Wrap it with the `[handl_all_i]` just like shown below.
